year. The new block was inaugurated by Smt. Anupriya Patel, MP, on May 15⁻ 2016. She was very appreciative of our efforts at providing quality education at a nominal cost to the deprived sections of our society. The inaugural function was well attended by the office bearers and members of the Round Table, Trustees of our Trust, Professors of BHU, distinguished citizens of Varanasi, our students and their parents and members of the local community. The function also received good coverage in the local press. The registration of new students is also steadily increasing. Our endeavour is to have one hundred students by July 2016.

Our aim is to provide quality education. The key to such education is the quality of teachers. A one week full time quality improvement training programme for school teachers was jointly organized by the Malaviya Moolya Anusheelan Kendra and the Faculty of Education, BHU from

December 29, 2015 to January 04, 2016. Two teachers of our school also attended this programme. We plan to train all the teachers we recruit for our school through similar training programmes.

Another important event was a medical camp held on December 13, 2015. It was organized with the help of Free Masons Lodge (Atal Sen Lodge No. 77), Four doctors examined and prescribed medicines for over 100 patients. Free medicines were also provided to them. We plan to organize such camps on a regular basis.

We have had four distinguished foreign visitors to our school Robert George, Mary Elizabeth Gosselink Clifford Wallach, Joshua Wallach visited the school in November 2015. Together, they have donated USD 37,000 for construction of three class rooms. We thank them for their generous support

This year we received 26 donations totaling Rs. 6.46 Lac. The number of new donors was 13 while the other 13 were repeat donors. The total number of our donors now is 182. However, both the number of donors and the amount received this year was considerably less than what it was last year. I appeal to you find to more donors to support our cause. We are also looking for donors who are willing to give Rs. 10,000/- per year to support the running cost of educating one child.

I look forward to your continued support to the school project.
